During the Company's two most recent fiscal years and any subsequent interim period prior to the engagement of Jewett, Schwartz, Wolfe and Associates, neither the Company nor anyone on the Company's behalf consulted with Jewett, Schwartz, Wolfe and Associates regarding either (i) the application of accounting principles to a specified transaction, either contemplated or proposed, or the type of audit opinion that might be rendered on the Company's financial statements, or (ii) any matter that was either the subject of a "disagreement" or a "reportable event."

Item 5.02 Departure of Directors or Certain Officers; Election of Directors; Appointment of Certain Officers; Compensatory Arrangements of Certain Officers

Mr. Wen Jiang, Chief Financial Officer of China Dongsheng International, Inc. (the "Company"), resigned from the Company effective August 20, 2008. Mr. Jiang's resignation was not the result of any disagreement with the Company on any matter relating to the Company's operations, policies or practices.

Mr. Aidong Yu, the Company's Chief Executive Officer, will serve as the interim Chief Financial Officer until the Company appoints a new Chief Financial Officer.
