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Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement

On June 16, 2016, BioTime, Inc. (the “Company”) entered into an underwriting agreement (the “Underwriting Agreement”) with Oppenheimer & Co. Inc., as representative of the several underwriters (the “Underwriters”), relating to the issuance and sale of 7,322,176 shares of common stock, no par value per share (the “Common Stock”). The public offering price for each share of Common Stock is \$2.39.

The Underwriting Agreement contains customary representations, warranties and agreements by the Company, customary conditions to closing, indemnification obligations of the Company and the Underwriters, including for liabilities under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the “Securities Act”), other obligations of the parties and termination provisions. The representations, warranties and covenants contained in the Underwriting Agreement were made only for purposes of such agreement and as of specific dates, were solely for the benefit of the parties to such agreement, and may be subject to limitations agreed upon by the contracting parties, including being qualified by confidential disclosures exchanged between the parties in connection with the execution of the Underwriting Agreement.

Pursuant to the Underwriting Agreement, subject to certain exceptions, the Company agreed not to sell or otherwise dispose of any of the Company’s Common Stock held by them for a period ending 90 days after the date of the Underwriting Agreement without first obtaining the written consent of Oppenheimer & Co. Inc., subject to certain exceptions.

The Common Stock is being offered and sold pursuant to the Company’s effective shelf registration statement on Form S-3 and an accompanying prospectus (Registration Statement No. 333-201824) filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) on February 2, 2015 and declared effective by the SEC on February 12, 2015, and a preliminary and final prospectus supplement filed with the SEC in connection with the Company’s takedown relating to the offering. A copy of the opinion of K&L Gates LLP relating to the legality of the issuance and sale of the shares of Common Stock in the offering is attached as Exhibit 5.1 hereto.

The net proceeds to the Company from the sale of the shares of Common Stock is expected to be approximately \$16.25 million, after deducting underwriting discounts and commissions and other estimated offering expenses payable by the Company, assuming no exercise by the Underwriters of the 30-day option which the Company has granted the Underwriters under the terms of the Underwriting Agreement to purchase up to an additional 1,098,326 shares of Common Stock to cover over-allotments, if any. The offering is expected to close on or about June 21, 2016, subject to customary closing conditions.

The foregoing description of the terms of the Underwriting Agreement does not purport to be complete and are subject to, and qualified in their entirety by reference to, the Underwriting Agreement, which is filed herewith as Exhibit 1.1 and is incorporated herein by reference.

On June 16, 2016, the Company issued a press release announcing that it had priced the offering. A copy of the press release is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 to this Current Report on Form 8-K and is incorporated herein by reference.
