The restricted stock units are eligible to vest in equal increments of up to 25% at the end of fiscal years 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 based upon the extent to which certain EBITDA
- (1) performance targets have been met for the applicable fiscal year. Based upon the Company's achievement with respect to the EBITDA performance criteria for 2014, 100% of the restricted stock units subject to such criteria vested, resulting in the vesting of 625 restricted stock units.
 - On February 6, 2013, the reporting person was granted 2,250 restricted stock units. The restricted stock units are eligible to vest in equal increments of up to 25% at the end of fiscal years 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 based upon the extent to which certain EBITDA
- (2) performance targets have been met for the applicable fiscal year. Based upon the Company's achievement with respect to the EBITDA performance criteria for 2014, 100% of the restricted stock units subject to such criteria vested, resulting in the vesting of 562 restricted stock units.
 - On February 5, 2014, the reporting person was granted 2,000 restricted stock units. The restricted stock units are eligible to vest in equal increments of up to 25% at the end of fiscal years 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 based upon the extent to which certain EBITDA

 - On February 6, 2013, the reporting person was granted 8,500 stock appreciation rights. The stock appreciation rights are eligible to vest in equal increments of up to 25% at the end of fiscal years 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 based upon the extent to which certain EBITDA
- (5) performance targets have been met for the applicable fiscal year. Based upon the Company's achievement with respect to the EBITDA performance criteria for 2014, 100% of the stock appreciation rights subject to such criteria vested, resulting in the vesting of 2,125 stock appreciation rights.
 - On February 5, 2014, the reporting person was granted 7,000 stock appreciation rights. The stock appreciation rights are eligible to vest in equal increments of up to 25% at the end of fiscal years 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 based upon the extent to which certain EBITDA
- (6) performance targets have been met for the applicable fiscal year. Based upon the Company's achievement with respect to the EBITDA performance criteria for 2014, 100% of the stock appreciation rights subject to such criteria vested, resulting in the vesting of 1,750 stock appreciation rights.
