(1) These shares were sold pursuant to a 10b5-1 Trading Plan established by the Reporting Person on November 23, 2010.

The price reported in column 4 is a weighted average price reported in reliance on a letter from the Office of Chief Counsel, Securities and Exchange Commission's Division of Corporate Finance to the Society of Corporate Securities & Corporate Governance Professionals dated June 25, 2008. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$8.70 to \$9.06, inclusive.
