Reference is made to the Statement on Schedule 13D filed on November 30, 2001 as amended by Amendment No. 1 thereto filed October 4, 2002, Amendment No. 2 thereto filed February 25, 2003, Amendment No. 3 thereto filed April 5, 2004, Amendment No. 4 thereto filed July 30, 2004 and Amendment No. 5 thereto filed September 29, 2004 (as so amended, the "Schedule 13D") on behalf of General Electric Company, a New York corporation ("GE"), GE Asset Management Incorporated, a Delaware corporation and a wholly owned subsidiary of GE ("GEAM"), General Electric Pension Trust, a New York common law trust ("GEPT"), and Insurance Private Equity Investors, L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company and a wholly owned subsidiary of GEPT ("Insurance"). GE, GEAM, GEPT and Insurance are sometimes referred to herein individually as a "Reporting Person" and collectively as the "Reporting Persons." Insurance, GEPT and GEAM each expressly disclaim that they are members of a "group." GE disclaims beneficial ownership of all shares and expressly disclaims that it is a member of a "group." All capitalized terms used without definition in this Amendment No. 6 to Schedule 13D shall have the meanings set forth in the Schedule 13D.

ITEM 5. INTEREST IN SECURITIES OF THE ISSUER

Item 5 of the Schedule 13D is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

- "(a) Each of Insurance, GEPT and GEAM beneficially owns 1,992,713 Common Shares, representing 2.74%(1) of the Common Shares. Insurance, GEPT, GEAM and GE each expressly disclaim that they are members of a "group" as such term is used in Section 13(d)(3) of the Exchange Act.
- (b) Insurance, GEAM and GEPT share the power to vote or direct the vote and power to dispose or direct the disposition of, 1,992,713 Common Shares, subject to the restrictions on voting described in Item 6 below. GE disclaims any voting or dispositive power over the shares beneficially owned by GEPT, GEAM or Insurance.

To the best knowledge of the Reporting Persons, no person other than the Insurance, GEAM and GEPT has the power to vote or to direct the vote or to dispose or direct the disposition of any of the securities which they may be deemed to beneficially own.

(1) This percentage is based on 72,851,594 Common Shares outstanding, calculated by combining the 35,524,092 Common Shares outstanding as of September 30, 2005 as set forth in the Issuer's Form 10-Q for the quarter then ended, with 37,327,502 Preference Shares converted on a one-for-one basis into Common Shares as set forth in the Issuer's Forms 8-K, dated November 28, 2005 and December 30, 2005.
