(1) The average of the high and low sales price per share on December 31, 2009, the last day of the related performance period.

The number of Units paid, which could have been 0% to 200% of the base number of Units granted, depended 50% on cumulative net income and 50% on cumulative total cash flow, net of debt during the 3-year performance period ending December 31, 2009. This Form 4 reports the conversion of 6,000 Units, 100% of the base number of units granted, payable 50% in common stock, 50% in cash.

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Performance Unit Grant of a maximum of 6,476 units (150% of the base number of Units granted) under the 2008 Performance Plan, contingently payable (to the extent earned) 100% in shares of Common Stock, in February, 2013. The grantee may elect to defer (in

- (3) Common Stock equivalents) all or a portion of the grant earned. Amounts deferred will be paid in shares of Common Stock. The number of Units paid, which can be zero to 6,476 Units, depends 50% on the attainment of a net income target and 50% on the attainment of a cash flow target over a 1-year period ending December 31, 2010.
- (4) Non-Qualified Stock Option in respect of shares of common stock granted under the 2008 Performance Plan.
- (5) The option vests and becomes exercisable in 25% increments over four years commencing one year after the date of grant.
- (6) Restricted Stock Units, each equivalent to a share of common stock, granted under the 2008 Performance Plan.
- (7) The Restricted Stock Units vest and convert into shares of common stock in 33% increments each year commencing three years after the date of grant.
